It is once again time to kick off our 2023 Wreaths Across America (WWA) campaign. Their mission is to REMEMBER the fallen - HONOR those who serve, and TEACH our children the value of freedom. Last year, at over 3,728 locations both here and on foreign soil, over 2.7 million wreaths were placed. Of the estimated 2 million volunteers nationwide who placed wreaths in those cemeteries 1/3 of them were children. Of that number, 15,200 wreaths went to the National Cemetery of the Alleghenies (NCA) located in Washington County, PA. This year those buried at the NCA number over 25,000. Again, this year we will go with the "3-for-2" option. This means that for every two wreaths sponsored, the cemetery will get three. Unfortunetly, for the first time in the 25+ years Wreaths Across America has been in existence, they have had to increase the cost of wreaths from \$15.00 to \$17.00 each. So if you purchase two at \$17.00 each the National Cemetery of the Alleghenies will receive three. Buy 4 and they will receive six. Purchase 10, and they will receive 15. Last year, with your help, our George Washington Chapter got sponsors for 3,197 wreaths. The George Washington Chapter continues the distinction of being one of the largest out of over 30 other groups to get wreath sponsorships for the National Cemetery of the Alleghenies. Again last year, for the sixth consecutive year, with graves that were already decorated by families, every grave was marked. What a beautiful sight! If you have purchased wreaths in the past, we sincerely thank you. If you have not, we would ask you to please look at the enclosed form and consider sponsoring a wreath(s) this year. You are also encouraged to join fellow Compatriots, Veterans, Scout groups, family, friends and students on Saturday December 16, 2023 rain, snow or shine at noon at the National Cemetery of the Alleghenies or if you do not live in this area find a National Cemetery near you to help place wreaths. It is a humbling and gratifying experience. Remember "in life they served their country and now it's a chance for us to honor them".
